PROVIDER FINGERPRINTING INFORMATION

Mandatory fingerprinting for providers applying to either volunteer or work for an agency will begin on July 1, 2014. Carolyn will be in charge of distributing the cards. While providers will be able to obtain their fingerprinting card from the Rappahannock EMS Council, each person will need to go to their local law enforcement agency in order to be printed. THE PRINTING MUST BE DONE IN INK, not electronically. In order to minimize confusion, I reached out to area law enforcement agencies regarding when providers may come in to be fingerprinted, and whether or not there will be a cost to the individuals being printed. Please see the list below for hours, cost, locations where fingerprinting may be performed, and contact numbers for each agency. Most of the agencies accept only cash or checks for payment. It is very important that the information requested on the fingerprint card provided by OEMS be completed in its entirety – if not there may be a delay in the processing of the request. In addition, the cards cannot be folded and mailed to OEMS – they must remain flat. Thank you for your attention to this detail.

Caroline residents may be fingerprinted for **free**. Individuals who work or volunteer in Caroline are also exempt from fees. Fingerprinting is done every day during shift changes (between 7-8 AM, 3-4 PM, and 9-10 PM) 804-633-1120

The Sheriff's Office performs fingerprinting of civilians Monday through Friday, from 9 AM to 4 PM. The cost is \$10. 540-422-8600

• City of Fredericksburg: Fredericksburg Police Department 2200 Cowan Boulevard Fredericksburg, VA 22401

The Fredericksburg Police take civilian fingerprints on Wednesdays, between 10 AM and 3 PM. They have generously agreed to provide this service **free** of charge to EMS providers. If personnel at the police department question this, have them contact Captain Purcell. 540-373-3122

The King George County Sheriff's Office provides fingerprinting services **free** of charge from 11 AM to 1 PM on Tuesdays and Thursdays. 540-775-2049

Those who work, volunteer, or reside in Orange County may be fingerprinted **free** of charge. There are no set hours for fingerprinting, and no appointments necessary. 540-672-1200

Fingerprinting is done on Wednesday from 8:30-11 AM and 1-4 PM, and on Sunday from 9-11 AM **free** of charge for providers. No appointment necessary. 540-657-5300

Fingerprinting is done on Wednesdays and Fridays from 1-3:30 PM. Those who work or volunteer, in Spotsylvania County may be fingerprinted **free** of charge. 540-507-7200

Mondays from 1 – 3 PM. County residents may be fingerprinted free of charge. 540-658-4450
