- 2.) ALS Release Train the Trainer program. Linda reports that the TTT program is going well. There are 4-5 Preceptor Trainers in the REMS region currently.

3.) Skill Drill program. This program is still intact until the governor signs the bill that will allow EMS providers to be automatically recerted once they complete all of the necessary recertification hours for their level. Agencies can still test their providers on the Skill Drills but at that time it will no longer be a requirement for recertification. Once the governor signs the bill it will take about 30 days to go live.

Linda also reported on the new OEMS guidelines starting January 1, 2014. There will be no more written tests administered at Consolidated Test Sites with the exception of instructor written tests and retest for the enhanced level. If a provider is not affiliated with an agency and needs to recertify they will need to take the NREMT written exam at a Pearson Vue site. And there is a fee for this test. This will also cover the provider that is in reentry. More information will be coming from OEMS later this week and will be delivered to the agencies.

Unfinished Business:

New Business:1. Memo from Pediatrician- a memo from Fall Hill Pediatrics was read. Dr. Horvath is interested and willing to have EMS students to come thru their office to gain patient contacts. The paperwork is in the process of being completed so this can start in 2014. If G & T members have any other ideas on where or who to go to for more things like this please let REMS staff know.

2. Wayne Perry- Something that Wayne would like the committee to review and create a process is providers who do not take our ALS courses but want to get college credit thru Germanna. When a student has been thru one of our classes we can attest for his/her skill level and can approve/disapprove that person to receive the college credit. But we do not have that knowledge with someone who has attend a course somewhere else. Verifying the skills of this person would be time consuming. Wayne is asking that the G & T committee create a process & associated fees for this testing/review program. This is something that can be brought to the next G & T meeting.

Unfinished Business:

Request from Spotsylvania Fire, Rescue and Emergency Management--Last meeting Greg Leitz presented their version of an EMS Orientation program to include both BLS and ALS Precepting. They are asking for this to substitute for the current REMS ALS release program. They are also asking for a vote of support for this program and what else a ALS Provider would need to do once they complete this program and are released to function as ALS in Spotsylvania to then be released in the REMS region. This was tabled until committee members could review the document.

After some discussion the motion was made to accept the program with 2 corrections/ additions by Pat Fitzgerald, motion was seconded by Victor Podbielski. Motion passed. The two corrections/ additions were the ALS release book stated that there were 3 documents that needed to be signed as part of the final release. But when the signed document was received by REMS for the first provider to complete the program the three documents had been incorporated into a single document. The committee would like the wording changed. They would also like to see the pages of the book and the release document date stamped and if there are any changes to the precepting book the date stamp is be changed. This is to assure that REMS has the most current copy of the book. There was a motion made by Victor Podbielski, seconded by Mark Garnett that one the final release document is received by REMS, the council will generate a memo/letter stating that this provider has completed the Spotsylvania FREM ALS release program that is equal to or exceeds the program currently used by the REMS Council and the said provider is released in the REMS region. Spotsylvania will also need to provide copies all certification cards for the provider. The above document will be added to the provider ALS release file at REMS. This motion passed

New Business:

Victor Podbielski talked about a situation that they experienced with Fredericksburg Fire Dept. A recent hire was released in with another agency but had not gone through the REMS release process. They did receive all the documents that the agency used for release. Victor then took this information to their OMD and he chose to release this provider for Fredericksburg Fire Only. When he was explained the out of region release program they may want to proceed with that option in the future. He asked that those documents be forwarded to his email.

Linda Harris introduced another topic for discussion REMS ALS Preceptors and their qualifications. The current qualifications for a provider to become a ALS Preceptor are: Virginia Certified Intermediate or Paramedic; Current Healthcare Provider; Valid ACLS & PALS certifications; 2 years' experience as a released Intermediate or Paramedic in the REMS Region and currently affiliated with a REMS agency; a letter approval from the Chief/Director or designee from the agency in which the provider will be precepting. If a provider has completed the REMS ALS Preceptor Training and then take another positions or changes affiliation to another agency that is not in the REMS region can they still remain on the Approved REMS ALS Preceptor List? John Brandrup stated that for as long as he can remember as a board member the requirement has always been that they needed to be affiliated with a REMS agency. During the discussion that followed it was decided by the committee that the requirements stay the same and if the provider is affiliated with an agency outside of our region they can no longer remain on the list.
