- Consistently provide effective direct care as part of the interdisciplinary team to a variety of complex patients.
- Manage care and implement treatment plans at a refined skill level in collaboration with patients, their families, physicians and other members of the healthcare team.
- Seek and provide feedback for improved clinical practice.
- Assume a beginning leadership role but seek mentoring in this process.

- Graduate of an accredited nursing program required. Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree preferred.
- 3 years of critical care experience required with five years preferred.
- Licensed to practice as a Registered Nurse in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
- American Heart Association (AHA) Health Care Provider BLS certification required.
- At least three years of critical care experience with five years preferred.
- BLS and PALS required.
- This position requires certification in the following areas within 6 months of hire:
  - EMT-B certification
  - Neonatal Resuscitation Program and/or STABLE
