AHA ONLINE BLS FOR HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS INSTRUCTIONS:

AHA BLS for Healthcare Providers Online Part 1 includes both the training modules, and a 25 question multiple choice cognitive test. Once the course and test have been successfully completed, you will need to complete a hands-on skills review and assessment session (approximately 30 minutes) with an AHA BLS instructor. This skills session **must** be completed in order to be certified. One of the advantages of this system is that it gives you access to the online version of the textbook for two years from the date of activation.

HOW TO ACCESS THE COURSE:

To access the course, go to www.onlineAHA.org and click on “all courses” in the “Course Catalog” icon in the center of the screen. In the **BLS – Basic Life Support** listing, you will then click on “**Add to Cart**” for the **BLS for Healthcare Providers Online Part 1**. The cost of the online course is \$22.

Once you have paid for the online portion of the course, you will be given an access “key” to the course. You will then be required to “**register and activate the key.**” This is quite simple, and the website will walk you through the process.

Please note that you can access this course from any computer that has an internet connection by going to <http://www.onlineAHA.org>. You will only have to register and activate a key the first time you enter the course; thereafter you can simply enter your email and password for entry.

Please also note that you will be given **two attempts** to pass the written test. Take your time.

SCHEDULE SKILLS REVIEW & TEST:

You will schedule your skills review and assessment with Linda Harris. Please be sure to review the BLS Adult AED one and two provider, and Infant one and two provider assessments prior to coming in for your skills review and assessment.
