- A. Review/confirm existing key strategies in the strategic EMS Plan
 - a. Plan must mirror the state plan and be in support of those goals. It is reconfirmed annually, and revised triennially. A large revision was made in 2015.
 - b. Core Goals: each goal broken down into initiatives and strategies. The committees needed to achieve these will need to be identified in the upcoming revision. The committees are a large part of how the Council functions but they are not specifically referenced in the document.
 - i. The committee went through and discussed each core goal and reaffirmed them.
 - 1. Goal 1 Develop and utilize partnerships / relationships: Fred stated that because REMS is a coordinating and influencing organization rather than a controlling organization, partnerships and relationships are key elements to the success of the Council.
 - 2. Goal 2 help coordinate and assist in regional emergency and disaster planning: Wayne mentioned that this has become more heavily emphasized in our contractual obligations.
 - 3. Goal 3—Strengthen regional EMS provider supply, education, and training: Wayne stated it varies as far as where and how training is provided; previous attempts at partnership with Germanna Community College for the Paramedic program were unsuccessful.
 - a. "Supply" needs clarification, and possibly the addition of text addressing the standards of care
 - b. Guidelines and Training may be the best committee to designate for this
 - 4. Goal 4—Strengthen Council resources and infrastructure: focus for this may be fundraising
 - 5. Goal 5—Coordinate and actively participate in improving community emergency preparedness: Mobile Integrated Healthcare, HeartSafe Community, etc.
 - ii. Discussion about possible additional goals or additions to goals:
 - 1. Include specific language regarding the dissemination of information and integration of best medical practices into protocols analysis of data to inform protocol adjustments, etc.

 - a. Wayne suggested the development of a RACI sheet that breaks down each strategy and those responsible for them
- C. Timeline for next OEMS update: the committee needs to have a preliminary draft in February so that the board may give feedback, then the committee may finalize its recommendation to the board by April.
