You must schedule a time to meet **3 days before the March 5th deadline**. That meeting is set aside for you to explain your grant needs and let the committee ask questions that may arise during the grading process. 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Also, the fall 2018 Nasal Naloxone for EMS Agencies (NNEA) grant application deadline is **March 29, 2019 at 5 p.m.** All licensed EMS agencies are eligible to apply for Nasal Naloxone regardless of prior funding status. Eligible applicants may apply through E-GIFT to have the Naloxone shipped at NO COST to their agency. Please see the user guides below to navigate E-GIFT and apply for this grant opportunity.
