I. Approval of Minutes

June 4, 2018 meeting minutes approved as submitted.

II. Old Business

- A. Strategic EMS Plan updates 2020-2023
 - a. Wayne has been constructing a table to track deliverable progress and the assignment of responsibilities and approval dates. He hopes to develop a one page sheet to put into the Strategic Plan as a reference.
 - i. Items are divided by committee, board, or staff
 - ii. Items that are in addition to contract requirements or outside of the scope of the Strategic Plan are included, but not numbered. The committee discussed assignment of responsibility for or elimination of some remaining items, including:
 - 3.2d provision of training for providers at Paramedic level. After some discussion, the committee decided that the provision of paramedic training should be reworded to monitoring the need for training, to be reevaluated in a year and with the idea that the Council will respond if need is identified.
 - 2. 3.2g—provision of ALS training sites for each of two planning districts; the committee decided to remove.
 - 3. 3.2h—promote/develop recruitment and retention programs for EMS Providers; after discussion, the committee decided to retain this portion and have the Council serve in an administrative capacity to assist the localities with general EMS recruitment materials and tracking possible events for agencies to attend. This has been assigned to Guidelines and Training.
 - 4. 4.2—assigned to the Executive Committee, to encourage appropriate individuals to participate as At Large members of the board.
 - 5. Inclusion of CISM Team in Strategic Plan –to make stress management and mental health awareness section more specific.
- B. RACI document Wayne to continue work on incorporating above changes and finalizing assignment of responsibilities prior to the next committee meeting.

III. New Business

- A. Discussion: vision and funding for the future
 - a. The Council needs to ensure that mandated requirements under the state contract are funded appropriately. For these services, the per capita ratio used to determine funding requests makes sense. Localities, however, are funding at disparate rates so the Council may want to consider reevaluating how we currently charge for the additional services provided outside of the contract requirements.
