The machine uses a series of algorithms to assess for the likelihood of a LVO in 2.5 minutes. This machine can not determine if the patient is eligible for endovascular treatment or not. Currently is in trial and is awaiting FDA approval. Plan is to be live in 2021 to determine LVO verse non-LVO strokes. Possible interest in REMS region participating in the field trials.

	Review of 2019 Update to the 2018 Stroke Guidelines which was released in October. Prehospital recommendations include education given to the public, physicians, hospital personnel and EMS personnel to increase the use of 911, to decrease stroke onset to ED arrival time and to increase timely use of thrombolysis and thrombectomy. Also recommendation for prehospital procedures should be developed for pts ineligible for thrombolysis and have potential LVO to facilitate rapid transport to thrombectomy capable centers.
