Unfinished Business:

- 2021 Trauma Triage Scheme
 - Still not able to approve the new 2021 Trauma Triage Scheme to add to Trauma plan/protocols for region because the red/yellow color designations don't align with current NEMSIS fields (currently listed as trauma triage criteria 1, 2, 3 4). Amanda has reached out to Bryan Hodges at OEMS to see if he can encourage the software companies/NHTSA to add the colors as options to NEMSIS fields. Mark advised this should stay on the agenda as a repeating topic.

New Business:

- NEMSIS Public Release Data Set
 - Kelsey has received the data but cannot open it due to size of the files. Will attempt to have Mark open it when we meet for work session in September.
- May 2022 Data Quality and Submission report
 - Discussed extensively; Kelsey will begin updating OEMS SuperUser list and contacting agencies who are not reporting to the state repository or have validation issues to help correct
 - Kelsey will attend an FRA meeting in Culpeper/Fauquier to discuss validation errors/failures to submit
 - Moving forward, OEMS will publish these reports one week after the end of each month for the previous month

- OEMS Field Reps will begin citing agencies with less than a 95% validation score once the July report is released; they will also be ineligible for RSAF grants as long as they are not in compliance
- Kelsey is still working to get all the REMS agencies into our tenant in ESO
 - Still pending status update from ESO
- Scheduled monthly reports for: (Mark advised these will be repeat topics every meeting; currently scheduled to run on 1st of every month for previous month, Kelsey will change to run on 3rd to capture any late reports; removed transport services from all reports)
 - Advanced procedures
 - Changed to provider ID # not provider level of who performed the procedure
 - Will ask MDC if they want a disposition column
 - At September meeting, Mark and Kelsey will work on rules
 - Ketamine usage
 - TXA usage
 - Toradol usage
 - Added column for patient age
 - Stroke assessment (FAST, VAN, BGL)
 - Will need to add primary “OR” secondary impression, instead of primary “AND” secondary impression once OR statements are released
 - Trauma assessments
 - Add Trauma Triage Criteria
 - Add Destination Transferred to
 - 12 lead completion timing
 - Will add patient refusal report (% by county) for Carlton
- Memorandum of Understanding draft
 - Table for now; Kelsey will bring other regions docs and OEMS doc for review/comparison next meeting
