SUBJECT: Temporary Protocol to address shortages due to hurricane Helene

Operational Guidance: Effective immediately, the following changes to the REMS Council Pre-Hospital Patient Care Protocols are implemented until further notice.

1. Conserve Flushes:

- 1. Explore alternative administration routes for medications, such as IM/IN.
- 2. Only start IVs if you intend to administer medication and an alternative route is not feasible.
- 3. Use flushes instead of hanging fluid.

2. Critical Patients:

- 1. For patients in hemorrhagic shock or with GI bleeds, where available, consider blood administration.
- 2. For patients in shock with a systolic BP < 90 mmHg and tachycardia, proceed with fluid administration.
- 3. IV fluids should be withheld for all other patients.
